## Hull Business Discretionary Grant Fund

**Funding Body:** Hull City Council

**Description:**

Grants to help small businesses, social enterprises and charities in Hull that may have missed out on previous Government support during the coronavirus pandemic. There is only one grant allowed per group. Applications are made via the group's local Asda Store's Community Champion and a total of £1,125 can be awarded per store. There are two types of grant:]

- **Hygiene Grant:** This grant is focused on personal hygiene dignity, supporting residents/patients in facilities, who are struggling and unable to provide their own toiletries either through lack of funds or access to family support. We would expect applications from care homes, hospices, hospitals and homeless shelters.
- **Healthy Holiday Grant:** This grant is designed to support groups that typically would be holding summer holiday activities to ensure children are provided with a hot meal. If social distancing is relaxed before school holidays, then standard (Transforming Communities Improving Lives (TCIL) criteria would apply (Option 1). If social distancing hasn't relaxed, we would provide grants for groups to deliver provisions to children at home (Option 2).

## Coronavirus Community Support Fund

**Funding Body: HM Government****Description:**

Emergency grants are available for small to medium-sized charities and social enterprise organisations in England to help them continue to deliver services to people and communities affected by coronavirus/COVID-19.

<b>Status</b>	Open for Applications
<b>Application Deadline</b>	None specified

Three kinds of grants are available:

- Grants from £300 to £10,000.
- Grants from £10,000 to £100,000.
- Grants for organisations working in partnership, from £10,000 to £100,000.

The funding is to cover an organisation's spending for up to six months after the award has been granted. Larger awards or longer timeframes will be considered particularly for organisations working across more than one area of England. This will be on a case-by-case basis.

It is anticipated that there will be a high demand for this funding and it will be oversubscribed.

**Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme (CJRS)****Funding Body: HM Revenue and Customs (HMRC)****Description:**

This scheme will provide a grant to all UK employers across all sectors (private, public, charitable and non-profit) to keep their workers on, rather than making them redundant during the coronavirus outbreak.

<b>Status</b>	Open for Applications

Employers will be able to contact HMRC for a grant to cover most of the wages of their workforce who remain on payroll but are temporarily not working during the coronavirus outbreak.

Salaries will be paid at 80% of their current level up to a maximum of £2,500 per worker each month, and minimum automatic enrolment employer pension contributions on that subsidised wage.

The funding will be backdated to 1 March 2020, if applicable. The scheme was initially open for four months and has since been extended by another four months, to October 2020.

**29 May 2020:**

The Chancellor has set out more details on how the Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme (CJRS) will continue to support jobs and business as people return to work, following the announcement of an extension of the scheme on 12 May.

From 1 July 2020, businesses will be given the flexibility to bring furloughed employees back part time. This is a month earlier than previously announced to help support people back to work.

From August 2020, the level of government grant provided through the CJRS will be slowly tapered to reflect that people will be returning to work. For June and July the Government will continue to pay 80% of people's salaries. In the following months, businesses will be asked to contribute a share, with individuals continuing to receive that 80% of salary covering the time they are unable to work.

From August 2020, the level of government grant provided through the CJRS will be slowly tapered to reflect that people will be returning to work. For June and July the Government will continue to pay 80% of people's salaries. In the following months, businesses will be asked to contribute a share, with individuals continuing to receive that 80% of salary covering the time they are unable to work.

The scheme updates mean that the following will apply for the period people are furloughed:

- June and July: The Government will pay 80% of wages up to a cap of £2,500 as well as employer National Insurance (ER NICs) and pension contributions. Employers are not required to pay anything.
- August: The Government will pay 80% of wages up to a cap of £2,500. Employers will pay ER NICs and pension contributions – for the average claim, this represents 5% of the gross employment costs the employer would have incurred had the employee not been furloughed.
- September: The Government will pay 70% of wages up to a cap of £2,187.50. Employers will pay ER NICs and pension contributions and 10% of wages to make up 80% total up to a cap of £2,500. For the average claim, this represents 14% of the gross employment costs the employer would have incurred had the employee not been furloughed.
- October: The Government will pay 60% of wages up to a cap of £1,875. Employers will pay ER NICs and pension contributions and 20% of wages to make up 80% total up to a cap of £2,500. For the average claim, this represents 23% of the gross employment costs the employer would have incurred had the employee not been furloughed.

## Domestic Abuse Safe Accommodation: COVID-19 Emergency Support Fund

The £10 million fund is being awarded in two rounds:

- Round 2 will award the remaining £1.85 million on a rolling 'first come, first served basis'.

MHCLG expect prospective applicants to apply for a maximum of £100,000 per individual bid, however, it will consider bids of more than £100,000 in the case of consortium bids or when bids demonstrate exceptional value for money.

- Long-Term Structural Change: grants of between £30,000 and £50,000.

The Fund also offers grants of between £5,000 and £30,000 for eligible individuals.

During the first funding round a total of £500,000 will be awarded in grants.
